2. CZECHOSLOVAKIA: WE ARE DOING A SHORT PAPER TODAY (TO BE
TELEXED) ON BILAK'S REMARKABLY FRANK STATEMENT AT THE SLOVAK
CC PLENUM ON IDEOLOGY THAT THERE EXISTS A SCHOOL OF THOUGHT IN
THE CSCP WHICH IS PRESSING FOR A "LET'S FORGET THE PAST"
APPROACH WITH REGARD TO THOSE WHO OFFENDED IN 1968.

3. HUNGARY: THE CC PLENUM IS BEING HELD TODAY. WE THINK IT
WILL COVER THE WHOLE GAMUT OF PARTY AND PUBLIC QUESTIONS
AND WILL NOT BE CONFINED TO MATTERS OF ECONOMIC REFORM. IT IS
PERHAPS INDICATIVE OF THE WINDS BLOWING IN HUNGARY AT PRESENT
THAT RADIO BUDAPEST, IN REFERRING TO THE PLENUM, QUOTED A PASSAGE
FROM KADAR AT THE 10TH PARTY CONGRESS WHICH ASSERTED THE NEED
FOR STRONG PARTY LEADERSHIP. ON THE BREZHNEV VISIT, THE BEL-
GRADE POLITIKA REPORTS THAT HE IS EXPECTED ON NOVEMBER 27.
