

HUNGARIAN PRESS SUMMARY:

FUGGETLENSÉG NO. 5 dated 2 November 1956
(organ of the Hungarian National Revolutionary Committee)

The strategic moves of the Soviet Troops.

The Soviet troops placed armoured forces right and left of the chief roads to secure the roads at Budapest, Szolnok, Karcag, Debrecen, Nyiregyhaza and Csap. The crossings have been strengthened by anti-aircraft artillery. Air-fields of TransDanubia have been surrounded by armoured groups to secure the bridgeheads at the TISZA and especially the bridgehead at DUNAFOLDVAR. The order of movements indicates that the troops will be first withdrawn from Transdanubia. The withdrawal will presumably be carried out at the bridgehead of DUNAFOLDVAR without touching Budapest. The air-field of TOKOL is surrounded by strong forces.

The strategic movements (done merely by tanks) indicate that they have no intention to attack.
