FIRST ADD VIENNA HUNGARIAN-BALLERINA X X X GERMANY.

IN THE PICTURESQUE UPPER AUSTRIAN TOURIST RESORT OF ST. WOLFGANG PRACTICALLY AN ENTIRE HUNGARIAN UNIVERSITY HAS BEEN SET UP.

SEVEN PROFESSORS, THREE LECTURERS AND 20 JUNIOR PROFESSORS OF THE HUNGARIAN MINING ACADEMY OF SOPRON ARE TEACHING 600 STUDENTS --BUT THEY ARE NOT ALLOWED TO HAND OUT DIPLOMAS.

SOME HAVE ALREADY BEEN OFFERED SCHOLARSHIPS BY FOREIGN UNIVERSITIES AND 40 YOUNG HUNGARIANS HAVE LEFT TO ATTEND DUTCH UNIVERSITIES.

MANY ARE PLANNING TO REMAIN IN AUSTRIA AND RECEIVE THEIR DIPLOMAS FROM AUSTRIAN ACADEMIES BEFORE THEY EMIGRATE OR RETURN TO WHAT THEY HOPE WILL SOON BE A FREE HUNGARY.

MOST OF THEM HAVE BEEN ACTIVELY ENGAGED IN THE FIGHT AGAINST THE RUSSIANS AND HUNGARIAN COMMUNIST FORCES.

ON OCT. 23, WHEN NEWS REACHED SOPRON OF STUDENT UPRISINGS IN BUDAPEST, THE MINING STUDENTS TOOK THE TOWN WITHOUT FIRING A SHOT. ALL RUSSIANS AND COMMUNIST HUNGARIANS LOCKED THEMSELVES IN THE LOCAL BARRACKS

ON NOV. 4, SOVIET TROOPS STARTED THEIR ATTACK ON SOPRON. IN THE EARLY MORNING HOURS, SOVIET TANKS RUMBLED INTO THE TOWN AND THE STUDENTS AND THEIR PROFESSORS DECIDED TO "GET OUT" AND CROSS INTO AUSTRIA.
