OUR "POLONIA" PROGRAM RECORDED TODAY AND SCHEDULED FOR MONDAY, OCTOBER 26, 1970 DEALS I.A. WITH THE VISIT THE LEADERS OF AMERICAN POLONIA PAID TO PRESIDENT NIXON.

THE VISIT IS DESCRIBED IN A POMIAN INTERVIEW WITH COL. KAZIMIERZ LENARD, DIRECTOR OF THE WASHINGTON OFFICE OF THE POLISH AMERICAN CONGRESS. THE PROGRAM ALSO QUOTES SOME EXCERPTS OF A POLITICAL MEMORANDUM SUBMITTED TO THE PRESIDENT. SOME SENTENCES NEED CLEARANCE WITH MR. WALTER'S OFFICE.

IN LISTING THE PROBLEMS DISCUSSED IN THE MEMORANDUM LENARD MENTIONS I.A.:

QUOTE: A REQUEST OF RECOGNITION FOR THE Odra-Nysa BORDER AND DROPPING NATO PLANS OF AN ATOMIC BARRAGE IN POLAND IN CASE OF SOVIET AGGRESSION. UNQUOTE

THE SAME IN POLISH: QUOTE ZADANIE UZNANIA GRANICY NA ODRZE I NYSIE. ZANIECHANIE PLANOW NATO W SPRAWIE POLOZENIA ZAPORY ATOMOWY W POLSCE W RAZIE ATAKU ROSYJSKIEGO. UNQUOTE.

OUR PROGRAM OMITTS A LENGTHY AND STRONGLY WORDED QUOTATION FROM THE MEMORANDUM AGAINST ALLEGED NATO ATOMIC PLANS BUT QUOTES THE PARAGRAPH ON THE BORDER PROBLEM AS FOLLOWS:

QUOTE: IT IS OUR CONSIDERED OPINION, THAT THE TIME HAS ARRIVED FOR THE UNITED STATES TO DECLARE THAT IT RECOGNIZES THE PERMANENCE OF THE Odra-Nysa BOUNDARY. SUCH A DECLARATION, ISSUED BY YOUR ADMINISTRATION, MR. PRESIDENT, WOULD HAVE FAR REACHING AND LASTING EFFECTS IN EUROPE AND PARTICULARLY AMONG NATIONS NOW SUFFERING SOVIET DOMINATION.

PRIMARILY, IT WOULD SUBSTITUTE THE AMBIGUITY OF THE BONN-MOSCOW PACT WITH A CLEAR CUT DECLARATION, SPECIFICALLY RECOGNIZING THE Odra-Nysa LINE, THUS TELLING THE PEOPLE OF POLAND AND OTHER SUBJUGATED NATIONS OF EAST CENTRAL EUROPE THAT THE UNITED STATES HAS NO INTENTION OF ABANDONING THEM AND FORSAKING THEIR MILLENNIAL RIGHTS TO BE RETURNED TO THE FOLD OF WESTERN CIVILIZATION AND CULTURE. UNQUOTE

IN REPORTING THE EVENT THE POLISH AMERICAN PRESS QUOTES PRESIDENT NIXON MENTIONING HIS RUMANIAN AND YUGOSLAV VISITS AND RECALLING HIS 1959 WARSAW RECEPTION. THE PRESIDENT HAS BEEN QUOTED AS HAVING SAID:

QUOTE: "NEVER BEFORE HAVE I SEEN SUCH A HUGE, SPONTANEOUS OVATION. THE PEOPLE ON THE STREETS OF WARSAW DEMONSTRATED THEIR FRIENDLY FEELINGS TOWARDS THE AMERICAN PEOPLE. BUT FIRST OF ALL - AS I UNDERSTOOD IT - THIS DEMONSTRATION WAS A KIND OF GENERAL IMPULSE MOTIVATED BY THEIR DESIRE OF RECOVERING THEIR FREEDOM, OF RECOVERING THE DEMOCRATIC FREEDOMS DENIED TO THE POLISH PEOPLE. UNQUOTE.

THIS IS A TRANSLATION FROM THE POLISH PRESS VERSION, WHICH RUNS AS FOLLOWS:

QUOTE: "JAK JA TO ROZUMIALEM, BYL TO POWSZECHNY ODRUCH I PRAGNIENIE UZYSKANIA WOLNOSCI I SWOBOD DEMOKRATYCZNYCH, KTORYCH NAROD POLSKI JEST POZBAWIONY, UNQUOTE.

PERSONALLY I HAVE NO DOUBT THE PRESIDENT DID MENTION LACK OF FREEDOM, BUT THIS IS A TOUCHY SUBJECT AND WE HAVE NO CONFIRMATION OF THE PRESIDENT'S EXACT WORDS. THEREFORE WE HAVE NOT REPORTED THE LAST PARAGRAPH AS A DIRECT QUOTE FROM THE PRESIDENT'S REMARKS, BUT WE PARAPHRASED THIS SENTENCE BY ADDING A COMMENT FROM RFE ANNOUNCER SAYING:

QUOTE: "THE DELEGATION LEFT THE WHITE HOUSE UNDER THE IMPRESSION THAT THE HIGHEST CIRCLES IN AMERICA ARE AWARE OF THE ASPIRATIONS OF THE POLISH PEOPLE TOWARDS FREEDOM AND DEMOCRACY" UNQUOTE.

IN POLISH-QUOTE: DELEGACJA OPUSZCZALA SIEDZIBE PREZYDENTA W PRZEKONANIU ZE NAJWYKSZE CZYNNIKI W AMERYCE SWIADOME SA WOLNOSCIOWYCH I DEMOKRATYCZNYCH DAZEN NARODU POLSKIEGO". UNQUOTE.
