EDWARDS REPORTS THAT STORY FILED THIS MORNING AS PP ONE ON  
U THANT AND HUNGARY IS AUTHORITATIVELY DESCRIBED AS "A LOT OF  
BUNK." THANT'S PERSONAL AID SAYS THAT SITUATION IS UNCHANGED.  
IT ONLY REMAINS TO SET A DATE. UNBROADCASTIBLY, SECRETARY  
GENERAL IS AWAITING OFFICIAL NOTIFICATION THAT THE AMNESTY HAS  
BEEN FULLY IMPLEMENTED. THERE ARE STILL HOPES BUDAPEST CAN BE  
ADDED TO THE ITINERARY FOR THE BUCHAREST BELGRADE TRIP EARLY MAY.  
STILL NO COMMENT WHETHER DOUBTS ON MINDSZENTY ARE BEHIND U.N.  
DELAY. UNDERSTAND D.P.A. HAS FILED, OR WILL FILE, STORY SIMILAR  
TO A.P.'S. SAME COMMENT APPLIES. HUNGARIAN DESK TDR'D SPECIAL  
NEW YORK THIS MORNING PROGRAM ON BASIS EARLIER REPORT OF  
CANCELLATION OF U THANT TRIP. THIS WILL CLEARLY HAVE TO BE  
KILLED NOW. REGARDS.
