

SCANTEIA, the main Romanian Workers' Party, daily carried an editorial approving the decisions of the wage increases taken by the Plenary Session of the Central Committee. An evaluation of the increase in wages and pensions by the Romanian Desk is being sent in the clear today.

Radio Bucharest carried a curt announcement of ~~Khrushchev's~~ <sup>Khrushchev's</sup> decision to cancel his trip to Scandinavia. The note explaining the reasons for the decision will be published in the Romanian press.
