TRADE WITH NORWAY.

Cvetko GRIGOROV, the commercial councillor of the Bulgarian Legation in STOCKHOLM, travelled to OSLO by plane on June 17 and returned on June 20. As Bulgaria has no trade representative in Norway, he was called to OSLO by the compensation trade concern "Norsk Kompensasjon" to conclude two deals: one was the purchase of sulphite cellulose and the other the purchase of sulphate paper by the Bulgarians to the total value of 700,000 Norwegian kronor. The deal went through satisfactorily and GRIGOROV is very contented.

Next week GRIGOROV is due to travel to COPENHAGEN to supervise the transport to Bulgaria of some pedigree cattle bought in Denmark. This will make it impossible for him to go home for his holiday, as he had planned earlier, to fetch his family to STOCKHOLM. Instead, his wife and two children will travel to Sweden alone GRIGOROV will take his holiday with them in this country later in the summer.
