1. STEHLE'S CORRESPONDENCE FROM WARSAW IN FRANKFURTER ALLGEMEINE ZEITUNG MENTIONS VARIOUS UNOFFICIAL STATEMENTS BY GOMULKA AFTER HIS RETURN FROM NEW YORK. ACCORDING TO THIS CORRESPONDENCE GOMULKA WAS TO HAVE POINTED OUT THAT POLAND NEEDED BADLY CREDITS AND COULD NOT DO WITHOUT THEM. GOMULKA IS ALSO ALLEGED TO HAVE SAID THAT "THE FIRST CREDITS FOR THE POLISH METALLURGIC INDUSTRY HAVE BEEN LATELY GRANTED BY THE USA." IT SEEMS TO ME THAT WE SHOULD TRY TO CHECK THE AUTHENTICITY OF THIS INFORMATION AS SOON AS POSSIBLE. AS IS KNOWN SIMILAR RUMOURS ABOUT AMERICAN HELP TO POLAND REPORTED IN F. KUH'S ARTICLE IN CHICAGO'S SUN-TIME OF OCTOBER 19 HAVE NOT BEEN CONFIRMED.
