

ECHO IN HUNGARY

(Borba, August 8, 1957) (*Yugoslavia*)

Budapest, August 7, 1957 (Tanjug) Laszlo Gyaros, spokesman of the Hungarian Government, today referred to the talks held between the top-ranking representatives of Yugoslavia and the Soviet Union in Roumania, and said that the Hungarian Government was glad to see that the relations between Yugoslavia and the other Socialist countries were improving steadily.

In reply to a question put to him by a Hungarian correspondent, the spokesman said that the Hungarian Government was confident that the present development of events would contribute to create even better conditions for future development of relations between Yugoslavia and Hungary, and that the Hungarian Government was doing its utmost to make possible such a development, said Gyaros.
