SOVIET ARMY

Polish coastal areas are under complete control of Soviet troops. Many Soviet soldiers have been observed in SWINOUJSCIE (former SWINEMUENDE) on the left bank of the Odra (Oder) river. Their billets, a part of the beach and of the port, are wired off and guarded. Poles are not allowed to swim in the "Soviet" sector of the water.

A concentration of Soviet troops has been observed further south near GRZYFICE (former GREIFENBERG.) The big barracks there are full of Soviet infantry.
