Government propaganda gave considerable publicity to the improved "Mitschurin" seed grains, allegedly imported from Russia to improve the local strain of grain.

On the bottom of many sacks small cards were found: "This grain was stolen from me," - written in Polish and signed by Polish farmers.

It was ordinary Polish grain, requisitioned somewhere in Poland.
