REUR MUN 43 OF 13 NOVEMBER:

IT IS NOT POSSIBLE TO APPROVE FOR BROADCAST THE FACT AND VIEWS SCRIPT YOU HAVE SUBMITTED, AS IT STANDS. THE PROBLEMS ARE THESE:

1. THE "CHRIST UND WELT" COMMENT IS ATTRIBUTED TO "THE GERMAN AUTHOR OF THE ARTICLE" WHICH SOUNDS AS IF IT MIGHT BE A "CORRESPONDENT" RATHER THAN A "REGULAR AND RESPECTED COLUMNIST." AS THE COMMENTARY IS OF AN INTERPRETIVE AND SPECULATIVE NATURE, IT CANNOT BE AUTHORIZED WITHIN THE LIMITATIONS OF OUR GUIDANCE OF ITS ORIGINATES FROM A CORRESPONDENT.
2. THE SAME SITUATION PERTAINS WITH RESPECT TO THE "FRANKFURTER RUNDSCHAN" EXCERPT UNLESS, OF COURSE, THIS IS A QUOTE FROM AN EDITORIAL.
3. THE "SUEDEDEUTSCHE ZEITUNG" EXCERPT WHICH ORIGINATES FROM THE PAPER'S ROME CORRESPONDENT IS OF A SPECULATIVE AND INTERPRETIVE NATURE AND HENCE IS PRECLUDED BY THE GUIDANCE.
4. THE "FRANKFURTER ALLGEMEINE ZEITUNG" EDITORIAL FALLS WITHIN

THE GUIDANCE, BUT TWO PHRASES ORIGINATING WITH THE RFE WRITER SHOULD BE CHANGED TO INSURE THAT NO "EDITORIAL" TONE IS ATTRIBUTED BY RFE TO THE QUOTATION. I REFER HERE TO THE USE OF "VERY CHARACTERISTICALLY" IN THE NEXT TO LAST LINE OF THE LAST PARAGRAPH ON PAGE THREE. THIS SHOULD BE CHANGED TO SOMETHING SUCH AS "TYPICAL OF OTHERS". AND THE USE IN THE LAST PARAGRAPH OF THE SCRIPT, SECOND LINE, OF THE WORD "RUMINATIONS" WHICH SHOULD BE CHANGED TO SOME SUCH WORD AS "COMMENT".

IF IT IS POSSIBLE TO SUBSTITUTE OTHER EXCERPTS FOR THOSE EMANATING FROM PRESUMABLY "CORRESPONDENT" SOURCES, IT IS LIKELY THAT A NEW SCRIPT COULD BE APPROVED. IF THIS IS THE CASE, PLEASE SUBMIT A NEWS TEXT FOR REVIEW.
