Since the night of July 6/7 1955, two Czech refugees are missing from the Camp 1002 WELS in Upper-Austria. As they had been observed selling all their belongings during the first days of July, it is assumed that they returned to Czechoslovakia.

Both refugees shared a room in the camp and were close friends. They were well liked by their compatriots, and are described as two simple, honest boys with no inclinations toward Communism. Only a week ago one of them is said to have stated that he cannot understand Ales MOLIN and how could an intelligent man like he go back to the Communists? The other refugee had carried on with a WELS girl for two years. She showed up in the camp two days after her Czech boy-friend disappeared and staged quite a show with her despair over her loss...
