Proposal to Mortgage Hungary's Uranium Deposits

An unnamed home service speaker commented on an AFP report that the Committee of Hungarian Refugees in Germany had appealed for a loan of up to 100,000,000 dollars from Western nations, offering Hungary's uranium supplies as security. Although it was impossible to keep count of the endless proliferation of committees claiming the right to represent - and to sell - Hungary, it was worth noting that this one considered it had the right to mortgage the country's uranium on behalf of the nation. "Any State or organisation prepared to give this dissident committee a hundred or even a thousand million dollars is welcome to do so." But should they ever try to foreclose their mortgage, they would fare as badly as the unfortunate Bulgarian market gardeners in Budapest who shortly after the second world war had fallen victim to a swindler who sold them the Vermezzoe, a public open space in Budapest.
