DATE OF OBSERVATION: November 1951

The following premises are used by the State "Alimentara" Society of BUCHAREST for food storage:

Colentina, Masina de Paine street, stores beans, chicory, sweets, etc. Six large rooms, 20 by 15 meters each.

Sos. Panduri, opposite the War Training School, stores oranges, tangerines, lemons, oil, olives, fish, chocolate, etc. This is an underground warehouse of 30 square meters. There are also warehouses in the ground-floor.

166 Teodor Speranta street, storage for rationed goods; oil, sugar, soap, flour, etc. There are six ground-floor rooms about 200 square meters each. Owing to insufficient space, rationed goods have been taken over to 32 Sos. Pantelimon. From there they are distributed to each district.

The Dumitrescu military premises on 28th of March street were converted to a storage for food and lately are used for the distribution of food, as well.

Three underground warehouses, 120 square meters each, are on 23rd of August street. Offices for forwarding and receiving goods are in the ground-floor. Some 16 to 20 people work in these offices. These warehouses are very often empty for months, hence the population does not receive any rationed goods during this period.
