DATE OF OBSERVATION: January 1956.

EVALUATION COMMENT: Of the names given the following are covered in our files: Dr. Jaroslav KVACEK (or KVACKA) former Consul General in DJAKARTA, and Czechoslovak Minister to Turkey in September 1955. Lt. Col. Premysl KOCOUREK, who was acting as Military Attaché in ANKARA in March 1952 (as a Major.) Jaroslav JACHIM was, in January 1951, Commercial Attaché at Czechoslovak Legation in CAIRO. Frantisek KINDL (or KINDAL) was assistant to the Commercial Attaché in ANKARA in June 1952.
