

Church/State

Information received here indicates that the clergy which attended the April 18 "Caritas" meeting were, in a good number of instances, pressured by the regime into doing so. Transportation was arranged for the priests at state expense, according to this information. Films were taken of the participants in the meeting, one such film was a newsreel immediately preceding a showing of the Swedish documentary "Mein Kampf" in which a number of priests were shown in the crowd.

German Question

Further information received here describes the popular attitude to the crises of Berlin and East Germany as considerably different from the modulated and relatively unemotional approach adopted by the regime information media. It may be that the very reticence of the regime in this regard is making the man on the street increasingly apprehensive. There would seem to be a policy of relative suppression afoot in the press and radio with respect to Berlin and other issues, notably the recent Papal encyclical.

Tunesian Minister

The Tunesian Minister of Foreign Affairs, Mokaddem, was received yesterday by Zawadzki, Jaroszewicz and Rapacki. He expressed his gratitude for Poland's support for Tunisia in international forums.
