

The paper brings a report with Tokyo headlines that Kadar stated on Saturday at a dinner that the uprising caused Hungary devastations but on the other hand it helped the Hungarian Government to see clearly "who is on our side and who is our enemy". Kadar referred to rumours about unrests in China when he said : "We Hungarians have heard that in China there are certain malicious elements who are hostile towards the Chinese people. We hope that the Chinese people, led by the Chinese Communist Party which has stood the test in many fights, will punish them.

The same day Kadar spoke at the Tsinghua University and in his speech he said :

"Only the working class has the right to lead a society; the decadent classes, like the Capitalists, have no right to lead. The friends of the democratic regimes demanded freedom. We shall grant full freedom to the working people, but never to the enemies of the popular democratic system. The Hungarian youth refused to be misled by the enemies of the people".
