POLANDPOLICEAgents and Confidants

The following Communists and police agents on the Polish coast have been named:

RATKE Antek, about 30, from the Maritime Office (Urząd Morski) in WŁADYSŁAWÓWÓ, is a police spy operating among workers and clerks of the fishing harbor administration.

DERG Stanisław, about 20, worked in a PGR ("sovkhoz,") is a UB agent authorized to carry a gun.

MACKIEWICZ (fnu), middle-aged, a Communist; until recently WOP chief at WŁADYSŁAWÓWÓ, now transferred to the Military School in WARSAW.

MIOTKI Bernard, bailiff (wojt) of STRZELNO commune, is a well-known Communist. He is responsible for expulsion of a number of people from his village, and for forcible confiscation of some living accommodation later allocated to Party members.
