RESISTANCE

On 3 June 1951, officers of the Rumanian Army arrived with two trucks at the A.P.A.C.A. workshops in BUCHAREST. After having presented all necessary documents, they took a large number of uniforms and disappeared.

Four days later another group of officers came to the A.P.A.C.A. workshops to collect more uniforms of the same kind.

After comparing both sets of documents the factory managers realized that they had been deceived by a well planned trick.

It is probable that this stratagem was carried out by local resistance groups, wanting the uniforms for their activities.
