TRAVELLING :

Every foreigner arriving in WARSAW must go to the registration office for foreigners with his "odcinek zameldowania" (registration form) and register personally. The officials there are polite to the foreigner and help him to complete his registration quickly.

Along the frontier and on entering and leaving Poland, foreigners are hardly subjected to the customs officials inquiries and searches. Poles, on the other hand, are controlled very strictly. A Polish-born visitor was asked to show his luggage for inspection; however, it was very carelessly searched. The Polish customs officers were polite to the foreigners who entered the country.
