HOWEVER, SINCE THEY WILL BE UNABLE TO MONITOR THE QUALITY OF THE TRANSMISSION THEY WILL NOT REBATE FOR MINOR OUTAGES OR DEFECTS IN SERVICE. THEY WILL STILL REBATE IN CASE OF A GENERALLY RECOGNIZED FAILURE ON THE CABLE.

MOFFAT ALSO STATES THAT THE QUALITY OF TRANSMISSION WILL BE ADVERSELY AFFECTED SINCE THE APPARENT HIGH FREQUENCY CUT OFF WILL BE REDUCED FROM THE NORMAL VALUE OF 3500 CPS TO AN APPARENT VALUE OF 1750 CPS WHEN THE TAPE IS PLAYED BACK AT NORMAL SPEED.
