Resistance At The Blast Furnaces In HUNEDOARA.

Rumanian saboteurs have carried out another act of technical sabotage at HUNEDOARA in Rumania. On 27 June 1951, the upper part of a blast-furnace blew up. Some pieces of coal had been filled with blasting-gelatine.

This sabotage succeeded only partly, because probably only a small part of the three kilos of gelatine reached in the furnace.

Because of the explosion, the furnace was abandoned and the respective bridge, the tracks and vans were destroyed.
