BROUGHT TO OUR ATTENTION TODAY:

MUNICH, MAY 14 (CMD) RADIO BUDAPEST SAID LAST NIGHT IN ITS
PROGRAM FOR HUNGARIANS ABROAD THAT RADIO FREE EUROPE "IS
SUPPORTED BY C.I.A."

THE RADIO SAID THAT A BOOK ON HUNGARY HAD BEEN PUBLISHED
RECENTLY IN THE UNITED STATES BY HUNGARIAN EXILES.

IT CRITICIZED ITS CONTENTS NOTING THAT THE AUTHORS HAD LEFT
HUNGARY MANY YEARS AGO.

IT ADDED BRIEFLY THAT THE AUTHORS OF THE BOOK "MOSTLY
ARE EMPLOYEES AND COLLABORATORS OF RADIO FREE EUROPE WHICH
IS SUPPORTED BY C.I.A."
