Polish Military Mission In EAST-  
BERLIN, Schlueterstrasse 42.SOURCE BERLIN: No information available.DATE OF OBSERVATION: Mid-Sept to 1 Oct.

About the middle of September 1952 three employees of the Polish Military Mission fled to the West. They asked the allied authorities for asylum and have been evacuated to the west. These three were: the manager of the legal and passport department JARZYBSKI (fnu); the interpreter of western languages and liaison officer with the western powers SWIATKOWSKI (fnu), and the secretary to the political manager of the Mission STANKIEWICZ, Mrs. STRZELECKA Zofia.

The place of Mrs. STRZELECKA was provisionally taken by Mrs. KUPCZYNSKA (fnu), an former employee of the Polish Information Center in the East-Sector. The vacancies of JARZYBSKI and SWIATKOWSKI are not yet filled.

Since the flight of these people strict control measures have been put into effect. The personal mail of all employees is being censored. All drivers who drive employees to or from the Military Mission have been told specifically not to stop at any place between the East-Sector and the Schlueterstrasse.
