1. BULGARIA: RABOTNICHESKO DELO ON AUGUST 22 PUBLISHED AN ARTICLE WHICH IMPLIES CRITICISM OF RUMANIA, AMONG OTHERS, ALTHOUGH IT DOES NOT MENTION EITHER RUMANIA OR CHINA BY NAME. THE KEY QUOTATION IS "WILLINGLY OR UNWILLINGLY THEY (I.E. THE IMPERIALIST UNDERMINERS OF SOCIALIST UNITY) ARE HELPED IN THIS SUBVERSIVE ACTIVITY BY THE "LEFTIST" AND RIGHTIST OPPORTUNISTS, ESPECIALLY IN COUNTRIES WHERE THEY ARE IN POWER. EMISSARIES OF IMPERIALISM TRAVEL ALL OVER THE WORLD, MAKE INTRIGUES, ATTEMPT TO DISUNITE THE SOCIALIST STATES, HATCH CONSPIRACIES WITH THE MOST REACTIONARY CIRCLES OF IMPERIALISM, AND SLANDER THE SOCIALIST STATES, MAINLY THE SOVIET UNION, AMONG UNINFORMED CIRCLES IN THE NEWLY LIBERATED COUNTRIES." THE ARTICLE IS AMBIGUOUS AND SEEMS TO APPLY PRIMARILY TO CHINA. THUS OUR ANALYSIS IN MONDAY'S D.R. OF BULGARIA'S ABSTENTION FROM POLEMICS WITH RUMANIA DOES NOT REALLY REQUIRE MODIFICATION.
