1. BULGARIA: BTA REPORTS THE VISITS OF YUGOSLAV ENVOY DRNDIC TO KYUSTENDIL AND PERNIK ACCOMPANIED BY LOCAL BULGARIAN OFFICIALS. THESE VISITS CAN BE TAKEN AS A FURTHER SIGN OF THE PREVIOUSLY NOTED IMPROVEMENT IN BULGARIAN-YUGOSLAV RELATIONS. DRNDIC HAS ALSO RECENTLY MADE A SIMILAR VISIT TO DOBRUDJA. HE HAS NOT YET VENTURED INTO PIRIN MACEDONIA ALTHOUGH IN KYUSTENDIL HE WAS PRETTY CLOSE TO IT.
2. CZECHOSLOVAKIA: THE BIG MATCH YESTERDAY PASSED QUIETLY WITH A FLACCID 3-3 DRAW THAT MUST HAVE PLEASED THE POLITICIANS BUT HARDLY THE FANS OR THE CONNOISSEURS. HUSAK, WHO ATTENDED THE MATCH, ALSO SPENT PART OF THE DAY CHAIRING AN ALL-COUNTRY MEETING OF LOCAL PARTY SECRETARIES. NOTHING HAS BEEN DIVULGED ABOUT THE DELIBERATIONS. THIS MEETING WAS PRESUMABLY TIMED SO THAT MOST OF THE PARTICIPANTS COULD ATTEND THE MATCH, CONSTITUTING A VERY "RESPONSIBLE" GROUP OF SPECTATORS.
3. HUNGARY: SEE NEWS ITEM (SENT DS) ON THE BUDAPEST INCIDENT LAST MONTH. REUTER CAME THROUGH WITH AN ITEM MUCH LESS SENSATIONAL AND MORE CREDIBLE THAN FARNSWORTH, WHO CONTINUES BIO.
4. POLAND: THE SZYDLAK COMMISSION ON ECONOMIC REFORM HELD ITS FINAL SESSION YESTERDAY. SZYDLAK AND JAGIELSKI SPOKE. ITS RECOMMENDATIONS WERE NOT REPORTED BY RADIO WARSAW BUT PRESUMABLY ARE IN TODAY'S PRESS, WHICH WILL BE AVAILABLE HERE ON MONDAY.

GRUDZIEN IS IN PARIS AT THE HEAD OF A PARLIAMENTARY DELEGATION AND MET YESTERDAY WITH CHABAN-DELMAS AND SCHUMANN. ACCORDING TO RADIO WARSAW THEY DISCUSSED GIEREK'S VISIT, SCHEDULED FOR THE FALL, BILATERAL RELATIONS AND EUROPEAN SECURITY. OUR PARIS OFFICE WILL TRY TO FIND OUT MORE.

5. RUMANIA: THERE HAS BEEN PRECIOUS LITTLE ON THE WARSAW PACT MILITARY COUNCIL MEETING WHICH ENDED YESTERDAY WITH "FULL UNDERSTANDING" AMONG THE PARTICIPANTS. THE MEETING APPEARS TO HAVE BEEN AT THE VICE-DEPUTY MINISTER LEVEL EXCEPT FOR THE RUMANIAN HOSTS, WHO WERE REPRESENTED BY IONITA, GHEORGHE AND GENERAL ION DINCA, THE ARMY'S FORMER CHIEF POLITRUK WHO IS NOW FIRST DEPUTY HEAD OF THE CC DEPARTMENT FOR MILITARY AFFAIRS.

6. QOTHER: NOTHING
