A reliable person who left Poland on 9 December 1951, states that a Communist activist, one SZYSZKOWSKI Boleslaw, was murdered in the area between SLOWIN and GRODZISK/POZNAN region on 16 November 1951.

SZYSZKOWSKI is said to have been in charge of the control of harvest deliveries. It is presumed that the cause of his murder was his harsh treatment of farmers called upon to give up their compulsory quotas of crops.
