ACCORDING TO THE REGIME MEDIA SOURCE AT THE U.N., THE RESIGNATION OF POLISH FOREIGN MINISTER ADAM RAPACKI IS IMMINENT. RAPACKI WILL BE REPLACED AS FOREIGN MINISTER BY ADAM KRUCZKOWSKI, RECENTLY APPOINTED DEPUTY MINISTER AND THE SON OF THE WRITER LEON KRUCZKOWSKI. KRUCZKOWSKI IS REPORTED TO BE A KLISZKO-GOMULKA MAN, NOT FRIENDLY TO THE PARTISANS. PRESENT DEPUTY MINISTER MARIAN NASZKOWSKI IS ALSO EXPECTED TO RESIGN OR BE OUSTED SOON. THE FUTURE OF WINIEWICZ IS UNKNOWN BUT HE IS LIKELY TO GET A FOREIGN POST. A FAR-REACHING "REJUVENATION" OF THE FOREIGN OFFICE IS EXPECTED TO FOLLOW. THE PRESENT POLISH AMBASSADOR IN LONDON, MORAWSKI, WAS EXPELLED FROM THE PARTY A FEW DAYS AGO, ACCORDING TO THE SOURCE, AND HIS REMOVAL FROM THIS POST IS EXPECTED TO FOLLOW SOON.

GENERAL JARUZALSKI, RECENTLY APPOINTED POLISH MINISTER OF DEFENSE IS RATED BY THE SOURCE AS "A PERSONAL FRIEND, VERY CLOSE TO MOCZAR."

THE OUSTER OF THE "PRESS DIRECTOR OF THE INTERIOR MINISTRY" REPORTED IN THE "NEW YORK TIMES," 26 APRIL, IS NOT CONSIDERED IMPORTANT BY THE SOURCE. IT REPRESENTS AN ACTION DIRECTED AGAINST A MINOR PRESS EMPLOYEE ACCUSED OF HAVING GIVEN TO THE PRESS THE PERSONAL FILES OF TYKOCINSKI. WHAT IS SIGNIFICANT IS THAT THIS ACTION BY THIS OFFICIAL RESULTED IN A SUBSEQUENT PARTISAN PRESS ATTACK ON RAPACKI AND ON THE FOREIGN OFFICE AS A WHOLE.
