A State Control Commission also still exists in Albania and Bulgaria,where its chief is a Cabinet member.

In the GDR Willy Stoph was appointed Minister of Coordination and Control on July 15 1960 in a period of serious economic difficulties. He has to carry out decisions of the CC and the government.

It appears thus that Rumania is the first country to abolish the Control Commission.

It may be recalled in this connection that statements have been made at<sup>the</sup> Third Party Congress(June 1960) to the effect that the economic-administrative apparatus was considered as consolidated and that the repressive State functions were to be reduced.

As pointed out before,other control organs have been established in the meantime.Noteworthy is also the increased competence granted to financial institutions(Ministry of Finance,State Bank,Investment Bank.)

Preventive control measures were strengthened in enterprises and institutions in January 1959.
