ROMANIA

Toma Marinescu, First Secretary of the Bucharest Branch of the Working Youth Organization said yesterday that 90,000 Romanian youth including pupils, students and functionaries have performed 3 million "voluntary labor hours this year." In a statement quoted by Radio Bucharest, the First Secretary claimed that 90,000 youth in Romania's capital were working with 2,583 "brigades of patriotic labor."

Virgil Trofin, another youth leader, said that the activities of these brigades "mirrored youths love for and fidelity toward the Romanian Workers' Party."
