FURTHER REUR NYC 28 OF 4 MAY, DETAILED SURVEY OF CZECHOSLOVAK BROADCASTS TREATING POLISH AGRICULTURAL ACCOMPLISHMENTS SHOWS THAT 17 SEPARATE BROADCASTS WERE AIRED BETWEEN JANUARY 1 AND MAY 16. BREAKDOWN FOLLOWS:
