MEMBERS OF MILITIA AT RAMNICUL VALCEA

Major FILIP (fna), a fanatic Communist idealist and an ex-waiter, is chief of RAMNICUL VALCEA's militia. He is married and surrounds his wife with great luxury in CALIMANESTI, where he pays her a visit now and then. His mistress is a very beautiful Polish lady, who escaped to Rumania with her child and her mother after the German occupation. Afterwards, wishing to be free she sent her mother and her child back to Poland, but as she found she could not live without them, she later asked Major FILIP to let them return to Rumania. Major FILIP forged the documents in order to let her have a Rumanian identity card with a Rumanian name.

MARINESCU Badica, 37, is a member of militia; an ex-carpenter and a gypsy by birth. He is a Communist and was secretary of the Communist Party in RAMNICUL VALCEA until a short time ago. His father is a blacksmith in the community. Recently he was recalled to BUCHAREST where he was made chief of a staff section belonging to the Ministry of the Interior. He was also nominated deputy of the VALCEA region.

LIZEANU Lariza, Polish by birth and married to a Rumanian; she is employed by police with the Aliens' Control Office. She joined the Party only as an opportunist. Italian refugees state that they were helped by her to leave for Italy.
