The 3,400-ton vessel "Lulu," flying the flag of Lebanon, has been chartered to transport phosphate from KOSEIR (Red Sea) to BRAILA in May.

The 4,000-ton Greek vessel "Adriatica" has been chartered to load phosphate between May 10 and 15 for delivery to CONSTANTA.

The 6,300-ton Greek vessel "Miotis" has been chartered to transport manganese ore from POTI to BOULOGNE in May.

The 4,600-ton Swedish vessel "Ekeforce" will load sugar between May 14 and June 4 at CUBA for delivery to LENINGRAD.

The 2,500-ton Greek vessel "Sebasti K." has been chartered under the same conditions.

The 2,000-ton Greek vessel "Rita" has been chartered to transport timber from COCHIN to ODESSA in May.

A 6,000-ton vessel of unknown nationality has been chartered

to transport general cargo from POTI to BOULOGNE in May.

The 7,750-ton vessel "Maeta," flying the flag of Lebanon, has been chartered to transport cement from Poland to Turkey.

A 7,000-ton vessel of unknown nationality will load sugar at CUBA in May for delivery to a Black-Sea port.

The 1,500-ton Rumanian vessel "Sulina" called at PIRAEUS on May 2, bringing a cargo of 453,023 cubic meters of timber planks, ten tons of gourd grain and 500 finished barrels. Part of the timber will be delivered to VOLOS for earthquake rehabilitation.
