Additional "Soviet Experts" To Be Accepted By
Bulgaria

Recently the Soviet Government sent a commission to Bulgaria to examine the situation of the agricultural machinery stations in that country. This commission remarked that "Bulgaria does not dispose of a sufficient number of qualified personnel." The purpose of this statement was to oblige the Bulgarian Government to accept an additional number of "Soviet expert."

EVAL. COMMENT: It is true that Bulgaria does not dispose of a sufficient number of qualified personnel for the agricultural machinery stations and especially for the repair-shops. The last statement of this report, however, is somewhat imaginary, because Soviet Russia does not need any good reasons to dispose of her Satellites in one way or the other.
