rei Scaune District):

Textile Factory "Gh. Doja", working with raw cotton imported
om Soviet Russia and exporting finished textiles to Russia. The
ctory is entitled to retain a small percentage of textiles, which
wever, is insufficient so that the factory requires subvention
om the government.

The director is ROMAN (fnu), a former machinist. There are
me 2,000 workers, all of who are dissatisfied with their low
ges. Work is done in three shifts.

In spite of the number of machines and new buildings, the
oduction has remained on the same level; it consists mainly of
ilitary clothing.

Tobacco factory C.A.M., employing some 600 workers.

Foodstuff factory (formerly Zissu & Perez), employing some
0 workers. The factory is working to full capacity and many
oducts are exported to Soviet Russia.
