ANNIVERSARY--RESOLUTION

LONDON, OCT. 22-(REUTERS)--A RESOLUTION CONDEMNING "ACTS OF REPRESSION BY THE PRESENT AUTHORITIES IN HUNGARY" WAS PASSED AT A RALLY TONIGHT COMMEMORATING THE HUNGARIAN UPRISING A YEAR AGO TOMORROW.

THE RESOLUTION ALSO CALLED ON THE RUSSIAN AMBASSADOR IN LONDON, JACOB MALIK, TO ASK HIS GOVERNMENT TO CONSIDER THE IMMEDIATE WITHDRAWAL OF SOVIET TROOPS FROM HUNGARY.

REPRESENTATIVES OF THE THREE MAIN BRITISH POLITICAL PARTIES ATTENDED THE MEETING, WHICH ATTRACTED A LARGE CROWD OF HUNGARIAN REFUGEES.

HUNGARIAN--RADIO

LONDON, OCT. 24-(REUTERS)--MOSCOW RADIO SAID TODAY THAT THE UNITED STATES HAD PINNED ITS HOPES ON THE ANNIVERSARY OF THE HUNGARIAN UPRISING "TO DISTRACT ATTENTION FROM ITS IMPERIALIST PLANS."

IN AN ENGLISH-LANGUAGE BROADCAST BEAMED TO NORTH AMERICA, THE RADIO SAID WASHINGTON WAS "FEVERISHLY HUNTING FOR ANTI-SOVIET AND ANTI-COMMUNIST SENSATIONS" BECAUSE AMERICAN DIPLOMACY IS UP FOR TRIAL BEFORE THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY "FOR THE ATTEMPT TO ORGANIZE AGGRESSION AGAINST DEMOCRATIC SYRIA WITH TURKEY'S HELP."

COMMENTATOR ALEXANDER ALEXANDROV REITERATED THE SOVIET VIEW THAT THE HUNGARIAN UPRISING "WAS A PLOT WHICH DEVELOPED INTO AN ARMED INSURRECTION WITH THE HELP OF THE WESTERN INTELLIGENCE AGENCIES--THE AMERICAN FIRST AND FOREMOST."

ANNIVERSARY--NEWSPAPERMAN

BUDAPEST, HUNGARY, OCT. 23-(REUTERS)--AUSTRIAN NEWSPAPERMAN KURT NEUBAUER, A CORRESPONDENT FOR UNITED PRESS, WAS DETAINED AND QUESTIONED FOR MORE THAN AN HOUR BY POLICE TODAY AFTER PHOTOGRAPHING A STATUE OF POLISH GENERAL JOSZEF BEM, HERO OF HUNGARY'S 1848 REVOLUTION.

NEUBAUER SAID HE HAD JUST LEFT THE-NEARBY FOREIGN MINISTRY WHERE HE WAS TOLD HE COULD TAKE PHOTOGRAPHS OF MONUMENTS.

WHEN HE TOOK THE PICTURE OF THE STATUE AN ARMED POLICEMAN RUSHED OVER, TOLD HIM IT WAS FORBIDDEN, AND TOOK HIM INTO A POLICE BARRACKS A FEW YARDS AWAY.

PLAIN-CLOTHES AND UNIFORMED POLICEMEN QUESTIONED HIM AND RELEASED HIM AFTER CONTACTING THE FOREIGN MINISTRY, NEUBAUER SAID.

HE SAID THAT POLICE CONFISCATED THE FILM FROM HIS CAMERA BEFORE LETTING HIM GO.

HUNGARIAN NEWSPAPERS MADE NO MENTION OF THE ANNIVERSARY TODAY.
