A Vienna society "Save the Children" announced at a Press Conference that roughly one thousand Hungarian minors are still in children camps in Austria.

At the Press Conference it was also stated that should the minors request it, they will be handed over to the Hungarian Consulate in Vienna for repatriation. Some minors have already been handed over to the Consulate but - as the paper complains - many children influenced by anti-Hungarian inciting propaganda, find it difficult to make up their minds.

Among the exiled minors there are several Hungarian citizens of 14, 12 and even of 9 years of age. It is contrary to international law and common sense that these children in a strange atmosphere and alone should decide about their fate. Most elementary laws of humanity demand that all Hungarian minors now in Austria should be returned without delay to their parents, concludes the article.
