RE YOUR NYC 121 OF MAY 28, 65:

QUESTION 1: FULL LIST OF MEMBERS OF THE PARTY LEADERSHIP IS  
BEING TELETYPED IN A SEPARATE OPEN MESSAGE.

QUESTION 2: BELOW IS THE LIST OF ALL UB MEN PRESENTLY IN THE  
SECURITY SERVICE BRANCH OF THE MINISTRY OF INTERNAL AFFAIRS. THIS  
INFORMATION UNFORTUNATELY IS NOT COMPLETE, IT COULD NOT BE  
CHECKED WITH ZAWADZKI WHO IS AWAY.

1. MARIAN JANIC, COLONEL;

BORN SEPT 8, 1901. IN THE ARMY 1918-1921. FOUGHT IN THE THIRD  
SILESIAN UPRISING. WORKED IN CUSTOM SERVICE AND WITH POLISH  
RAILWAYS. FROM 1942 PPR MEMBER. IN 1944 MEMBER OF THE AL. WHEN  
MOCZAR WAS COMMANDER IN KIELCE PROVINCE, JANIC WAS HIS CHIEF  
OF STAFF. AFTER THE WAR JANIC WORKED WITH THE MINISTRY OF  
PUBLIC SECURITY. DUBBED ONE OF ORGANIZERS OF THE UB BY  
A REPORT FROM 1953. LATER IN THE MINISTRY

OF INTERNAL AFFAIRS. FOR A TIME, HE WAS REPORTED TO BE ON  
THE STAFF OF GEN GRZEGORZ KORCZYNSKI AND THEN AGAIN IN THE  
MINISTRY OF INTERNAL AFFAIRS. AUTHOR OF BOOK OF PERSONAL RECOLLECTIONS  
"IDA PARTYZANCI" (1963). EARLY THIS YEAR HE  
WAS IN LONDON IN ORDER TO ESTABLISH CONTACTS WITH POLISH  
EMIGRATION (IN PARTICULAR WITH MEMBERS OF THE HOME ARMY)  
ON BEHALF OF ZBOWID. AT PRESENT DEPUTY DIRECTOR OF THE  
CABINET OF MINISTER (VICE-DYREKTOR GABINETU MINISTRAL. HE  
IS ONE OF THE MEN CLOSEST TO MOCZAR WITH INFLUENCE MUCH  
GREATER THAN INDICATED BY OFFICIAL TITLE.

2. FRANCISZEK SZLACHCIC ONE OF THE DEPUTY MINISTERS OF  
INTERNAL AFFAIRS. FORMER CHIEF OF UB IN KATOWICE, ONE OF  
CLOSEST ASSOCIATES OF MOCZAR.

3. ZBIGNIEW FIJALEK;

REPORTEDLY ONCE IN UB SERVICE. UNTIL 1954 REPORTED  
QUARTERMASTER OF INTERNAL SECURITY FORCES; UP TILL 1959 WE  
HAVE INFORMATION THAT HE WAS ON THE STAFF OF THE MINISTRY OF  
INTERNAL AFFAIRS. IN 1962 REPORTED DEPUTY CHAIRMAN OF THE  
POLISH FOOTBALL ASSOCIATION. WE DO NOT KNOW WHETHER STILL  
CONNECDED WITH THE MINISTRY OF INTERNAL AFFAIRS.

4. MATEJEWSKI RYSZARD; BORN IN 1923. RIGHT AFTER THE WAR  
HE STARTED TO WORK WITH UB IN THE II DEPT. OF THE MINISTRY  
OF PUBLIC SECURITY. FROM DECEMBER 7 1954 DIRECTOR OF  
INVESTIGATION DEPARTMENT IN THE NEWLY FORMED COMMITTEE FOR  
SECURITY MATTERS. FROM NOV 13, 1956, APPOINTED DIRECTOR OF  
THE II DEPT. (COUNTER-INTELLIGENCE) OF THE MINISTRY OF  
INTERNAL AFFAIRS. IN FEBRUARY 1965 PROMOTED DIRECTOR GENERAL  
OF THE MINISTRY OF INTERNAL AFFAIRS.

5. KLEMENS RADZIUKIEWICZ, COLONEL; DEPUTY DIRECTOR OF  
VIII DEPT. OF THE MINISTRY OF PUBLIC SECURITY. REPORTEDLY  
AFTER THE FALL OF RADKIEWICZ, CHIEF OF POLITICAL EDUCATION  
OF THE CORPS OF INTERNAL SECURITY FOR A SHORT TIME. STILL  
IN 1958 REPORTED ON THE STAFF OF THE MINISTRY OF INTERNAL  
AFFAIRS. IN PRE-OCTOBER DAYS, HE FORMED AND WAS ACTIVE IN  
THE POLISH-GREEK FRIENDSHIP SOCIETY, AND IN GENERAL WAS  
DEALING WITH THE MATTERS OF GREEK EXILES IN POLAND. NO  
INFORMATION ON HIM AFTER 1958.

6. ANDRZEJ DABROWSKI.

REPORTEDLY EX-SOVIET OFFICER AND UB-MAN. FORMER CHIEF  
OF RADIO SECTION IN THE VII DEPARTMENT OF THE MINISTRY OF  
PUBLIC SECURITY. IN 1959 CHIEF OF A SUB-SECTION IN THE  
TECHNICAL CONTROL SECTION OF THE COMMUNICATION BOARD AT THE  
MINISTRY OF INTERNAL AFFAIRS. NO DATA AVAILABLE BEYOND 1959.

7. LESNIEWSKI (FNU), LT COLONEL.

ON THE STAFF OF THE MINISTRY OF PUBLIC SECURITY. LATER ON THE STAFF OF THE COMMITTEE FOR SECURITY MATTERS, THE IN THE MINISTRY OF INTERNAL AFFAIRS DEALING WITH SECURITY SERVICE FOREIGN BRANCH. LAST TIME REPORTED IN 1958. HIS WIFE WAS HEAD OF THE UB PASSPORT OFFICE, AND WAS REPORTEDLY SACKED IN 1957 BECAUSE OF ISSUING PASSPORTS TO A GROUP OF JEWS EMPLOYED BY THE UB.

8. HENRYK CHMIELEWSKI, PUBLIC PROSECUTOR.

ALREADY IN 1939 AGENT OF THE NKVD, ONE OF THE AUTHORS OF INDICTMENT AGAINST BISHOP CZESLAW KACZMAREK. TILL OCTOBER 1956 ON THE STAFF OF THE MINISTRY OF JUSTICE. IN APRIL 1957 MENTIONED AS DIRECTOR OF CONTROL OFFICE OF PENAL-JUSTICE ADMINISTRATION (BIURO NADZORU NAD ORZECZNICTWEM KARNO-ADMINISTRACYJNYM) IN THE MINISTRY OF INTERNAL AFFAIRS. REPORTEDLY AUTHOR OF THE LAW ON PUBLIC MEETINGS, WHICH WAS SUPPORTED BY THE "PARTIZAN" GROUP. LAST TIME MENTIONED IN CONNECTION WITH THE MINISTRY OF INTERNAL AFFAIRS IN 1962.

QUESTION NO 3:

GRZEGORZ KORCZYNSKI IS STYLED CHIEF OF GENERAL STAFF ADMINISTRATION (SZEFE ZARZADU SZTABU GENERALNEGO).

HIS SUBORDINATES ARE:

GEN ALEKSANDER KOKOSZYN, CHIEF OF THE ARMY INTERNAL SERVICES (SZEFE WOJSKOWEJ SLUZBY WEWNETRZNEJ). HE WAS TRANSFERRED FROM THAT POST TO ARMY POLITICAL ADMINISTRATION AT THE END OF 1964.

KUFEL TEODOR, COLONEL, SUCCEEDED GEN KOKOSZYN AS CHIEF OF THE ARMY INTERNAL SERVICES.

QUESTION NO 4: GENERAL WACLAW KOMAR WAS REMOVED FROM THE POSITION OF COMMANDER OF INTERNAL TROOPS (DOWODCA WOJSK WEWNETRZNYCH) SOMETIME IN 1959 AND APPOINTED DIRECTOR GENERAL

OF THE MINISTRY OF INTERNAL AFFAIRS ON 27 JULY 1960. HE IS STILL HOLDING THIS POSITION NOMINALLY, BUT HAS BEEN DEPRIVED OF ANY INFLUENCE.

ACCORDING TO "TRYBUNA LUDU" OF FEBRUARY 4, 1965, RYSZARD MATEJEWSKI WAS APPOINTED DIRECTOR GENERAL OF THE MINISTRY AND IS HOLDING THE REAL POWER ATTACHED TO THIS POSITION.

QUESTION NO 5: ACCORDING TO OUR REPORTS ROZANSKI WAS SEEN RECENTLY IN THE PASSPORT OFFICE AND THIS GAVE RISE TO RUMOURS THAT HE MAY EMIGRATE TO ISRAEL. NO INFORMATION ABOUT ANY JOBS FOR ROZANSKI, FEJGIN AND ROMKOWSKI, BUT ALL THREE ARE LIVING COMFORTABLY. REPORTEDLY COLONEL JOZEF DUSZA WHO WAS RELEASED FROM PRISON AT THE SAME TIME WILL BE RE-EMPLOYED BY THE SECURITY SERVICE IN VIEW OF HIS ARIAN ORIGIN. JEWISH BACKGROUND OF THE OTHER THREE SEEMS TO PRECLUDE ANY SIMILAR CHANCES FOR ROZANSKI, FEJGIN AND ROMKOWSKI.

QUESTION NO 6: COLONEL SIENKIEWICZ WITOLD. ACCORDING TO UNOFFICIAL DATA FORMER DEPUTY CHAIRMAN OF THE COMMITTEE FOR SECURITY MATTERS. ABOUT BEGINNINGS OF 1957, DIRECTOR OF THE FIRST DEPARTMENT IN THE MINISTRY OF INTERNAL AFFAIRS. ON THE OCCASION OF THE FIFTEENTH ANNIVERSARY OF PEOPLE'S POLAND DECORATED WITH THE BANNER OF LABOUR 1ST CLASS ON 22 JULY 1957 (CF "TRYBUNA LUDU" SAME DATE). LAST MENTION IN "TRYBUNA LUDU" OF 20 DEC 1964 AS DEPUTY CHAIRMAN OF THE FEDERATION KS "GWARDIA".

COLONEL CZAPLICKI: ACCORDING TO INFORMATION FROM 1957 WAS THE CHIEF OF THE FIRST DEPARTMENT IN THE COMMITTEE FOR SECURITY MATTERS AND LATER DEPUTY DIRECTOR OF THE FIRST DEPARTMENT IN THE MINISTRY OF INTERNAL AFFAIRS. AT PRESENT HE IS DEPUTY DIRECTOR OF THE STATE INSPECTION OF TRADE (PANSTWOWEJ INSPEKCJI HANDLOWEJ).

MAREK MAJOB UB- NO INFORMATION SINCE 1954.
