The source came from Western Poland, from one of the small villages located near the sea coast. He was the chairman of the local ZMP branch, comprising about 350 boys altogether. He was not holding this dignity by election; the higher authorities of the Union had nominated him to this post; he was paid for his work 400 Zloty a month.

His duties were: registration of members, preparation of meetings and lectures, and also interventions in factories and business enterprises on behalf of ZMP members. Political education of his section was in the hands of a special instructor Captain KAMIEN and of Lieutenant HOLENDERK from the security office.

All members of the ZMP have to sign a special form in which they undertake to fulfil different tasks, listed in eight paragraphs, one of the primary ones being active cooperation in the Six Year Plan.
