

Trade Talks

The economic-financial delegation of the Republic of Chile, which spent four days in Poland (June 21-24), discussed the broadening of trade turnover between the two countries, according to a communiqué broadcast by Radio Warsaw June 25. Information was exchanged about the extension of the list of goods, and terms and conditions were discussed of Polish supply to Chile of machines and industrial equipment on credit terms.

Similar trade talks were conducted in Warsaw by the Nigerian Foreign Trade Minister with his Polish opposite number. A joint declaration signed June 26 stressed the interest of both countries in the broadening of trade relations. Nigeria is also interested in Polish specialists and in the import of investment goods, including complete industrial objects. Terms and conditions will be established in future pertinent talks.
