The mausoleum in the Aleja I Armii in WARSAW, for the WARSAW Martyrs, will be inaugurated in the near future. The mausoleum has been built around the illfamed prison where political prisoners were confined during the German occupation and one wing of the prison, i.e. five cells with writings of the confined martyrs still on their walls have been preserved in the mausoleum itself.

Moreover, there are great plastic reproductions of the Nazi concentration camps where Polish citizens were interned, in the central hall of the new mausoleum.

EVAL. COMMENT: The Polish press so far has mentioned neither the erection nor the unveiling ceremonies.
