ROMANIA Radio Bucharest yesterday broadcast a long commentary on the Geneva conference which indicated that any suspension of negotiations will be blamed on the West Germans who are alleged to be trying to put obstacles in the path to a summit meeting. The commentary claimed that these were normal maneuvers for West German governmental representatives who inherited from Hitler not only fascist traditions but men as well.

In connection with this, the Romanian radio misquoted Norstad's Munich statements regarding the eventual arming of the Bundeswehr with atomic rockets.

Byelorussian week was celebrated in Romania and Dej formally received a Byelorussian cultural delegation.

Delegates from Yugoslavia and Romania, meeting in Belgrade, agreed to exchange information about methods of productivity.
