LETTER FROM PRAGUE: WE LIVE IN GREAT TENSION

SOURCE ATHENS: Letter from PRAGUE from a Greek partisan living in a Greek Communist community.

DATE OF OBSERVATION: November 22 1956.

EVALUATION COMMENT: This refers, it is believed, to the lynchings and near-lynchings of ardent Communist activists in Poland and Hungary by anti-Communists of both countries.
