MEAT SITUATION

The meat shortage in Rumania continues to remain acute according to recent information from that country. On 1 August 1951, 250 grams of meat were distributed to persons with "C" cards - the first distribution in BUCHAREST since April 1951.

The monthly ration of 250 grams can be bought in three qualities ranging in price from 55 Lei to 250 Lei per kilogram. The black market price for meat is about 350 Lei per kilogram, but it is seldom available.
