1. BULGARIA: THE DELEGATION TO MOSCOW, HEADED BY VENELIN KOTSEV, RETURNED TO SOFIA YESTERDAY. THE MOST IMPORTANT SOVIET OFFICIAL THE BULGARIAN VISITORS APPEAR TO HAVE MET WAS PIOTR DEMICHEV. IT WILL BE RECALLED THAT BILAK, ON HIS RECENT VISIT TO MOSCOW, ALSO MET DEMICHEV BUT THAT BILAK WAS ALSO RECEIVED BY BREZHNEV. EARLY IN MARCH A POLISH DELEGATION, LED BY LUKASZIEWICZ, THE NEW POLISH SECRETARY IN CHARGE OF THE PRESS, VISITED MOSCOW AND MET DEMICHEV ALSO.

2. CZECHOSLOVAKIA: WE ARE GETTING A FULL TRANSLATION SOONEST OF THE RUDE PRAVO ARTICLE ON HUNGARY (SEE ITEM SENT DS). FROM THE CETEKA RELEASE IT LOOKS AS IF IT MIGHT BE SIMILAR TO THE RECENT PRAVDA ARTICLE ON HUNGARY.

3. HUNGARY: YESTERDAY'S NEPSZABADSAG CARRIED DETAILS OF THE AMENDMENTS TO THE CONSTITUTION WHICH WILL BE PRESENTED TO THE NEXT SESSION OF THE PARLIAMENT, PROBABLY IN APRIL. EERA IS PREPARING AN ANALYSIS.

RADIO BUDAPEST ANNOUNCED THIS MORNING THAT A STRONG ECONOMIC DELEGATION, LED BY FOCK, WAS ON ITS WAY TO MOSCOW.

4. POLAND: THE HERALDED SESSION OF THE CC TAKES PLACE TODAY, 24 HOURS BEFORE THE MEETING OF THE NEW SEJM.
