Polish S/S "Lublin" In HAMBURG Harbor.

DATE OF OBSERVATION: 14 June, 1953

EVAL. COMMENT: This is a routine report on the movement of Polish ships in the HAMBURG harbor. It contains no news for the Programming Department, but is very useful for research purposes.

The Polish steamer "Lublin" (1409 BRT) arrived in HAMBURG from ROTTERDAM on 13 June at 19.30 hrs.

Her cargo consisted of 1584 tons of sheet iron, iron pipes, borax and nuts. A small subsidiary load of piecegoods was taken on. The "Lublin" left HAMBURG for GDYNIA 14 June at 13.30 hrs.

Since the last crew check (please see Item No. 5608/53) the crew has been increased by one member. Three crew members left the ship, among them the former captain, MILENUSZKIN Walenty; 4 members, among them the new captain, OLEJARNIK, Marian, joined the crew. Those who left are:
