THIS WAS ATTRIBUTED TO A SPOKESMAN OF THE U.S.

OUR LEGAL SPECIALIST IN THE CZECHOSLOVAK EERA UNIT
STATES THAT THERE IS NO NECESSARY LINK IN SENTENCING
ON THE TWO CHARGES AND THAT BOTH CAN BE TREATED
QUITE SEPARATELY UNDER CZECHOSLOVAK LAW.
