DIRECTIVE NO. 28, SECTION I, B., 1.:

"IT IS THE SOVIET UNION, OF COURSE," WRITES CLARK M.
EICHELBERGER IN U.N.: THE FIRST FIFTEEN YEARS, "MORE THAN
ANY POWER, WHICH HAS MAINTAINED A POSITION OF FIXED RIGIDITY
IN THE POLITICAL PHASE OF THE UNITED NATIONS AND A POSITION
OF OBSTRUCTIONISM IN ITS OTHER ACTIVITIES. IN PRACTICALLY
ALL AREAS THERE HAS BEEN THAT HARD ROCK, THAT FIXED
POSITION, THAT UNWILLINGNESS TO COMPROMISE, TO NEGOTIATE;
ONLY WILLINGNESS TO VETO...CONSEQUENTLY, FOR SOME YEARS
THERE HAS BEEN A SOLID BLOC OF NINE COMMUNIST STATES...
WHICH HAVE NOT BEEN PERMITTED TO EXERCISE CHOICE OR
OBJECTIVITY IN THEIR UNITED NATIONS VOTES...

"THE SOVIET GOVERNMENT CONTINUES TO BELIEVE IN A
DICTATORSHIP OF THE FOUR GREAT POLICEMEN IN THE UNITED
NATIONS. THAT GOVERNMENT'S USE OF THE VETO IN THE
SECURITY COUNCIL INDICATES THAT THE SOVIET INTENDED THIS
DICTATORSHIP TO FUNCTION ACCORDING TO ITS WISHES."
