ROMANIA

In commenting on the Geneva Conference, Radio Bucharest states that "all efforts toward a rapprochement had met with stubbornness of Westerners in ignoring reality and aspirations of Germany." The regime press continues to cull favorable Western press comment to the regime proposal for an atom-free zone in the Balkans. Radio Bucharest stresses that Tito is in agreement with the Romanian proposal.
